

IN-SHOP COLLECTION SYSTEM

With its in-shop collection system, TEXAID offers the possibility of handing in used clothes in places where they are sold – in shops.

HOW IT WORKS:

Collect unwanted clothes and shoes in a tear-resistant sack. (tie shoes together in pairs and close up the sack tightly)

Hand in the clothes sack at a TEXAID partner and get a voucher. You can find all in-shop partners by using our <u>Store-Locator</u>.

Redeem the voucher and make a profit.



TEXAID collects the clothes sacks, and at the sorting facility they then are divided up into wearable items and goods for recycling.

Closed textile cycles are necessary in order to conserve valuable resources and the environment. TEXAID makes a valuable contribution to this by collecting, carefully sorting and returning to the recycling loop discarded textiles professionally and in an ecologically sound way.

By selling the textiles, TEXAID generates funds for charities. Every year, payments running into the millions are made to the participating aid organizations, Samaritans' associations, Kolping families and many regional non-profit organizations. Money that is used for social projects at home and abroad.
